# Support for the e-voucher

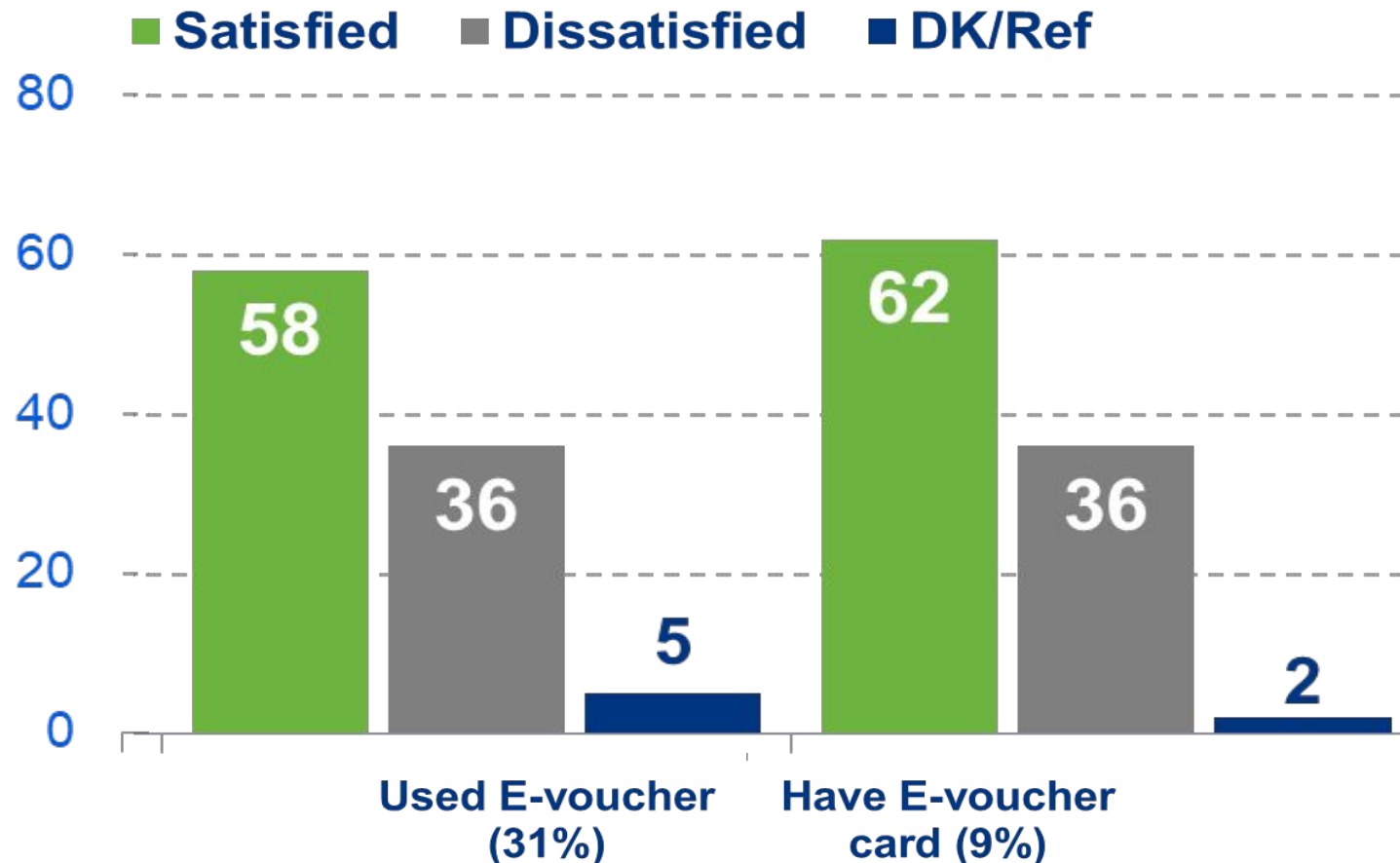
Polling of the public and MPs show that:

- Farmers who have used the e-voucher are supportive.
- ‘Elites’ recognise that the e-voucher is a better policy than traditional FISP and that problems with it are failures of implementation.

With its users supportive and MPs convinced of the benefits, there is a public mandate **and** political will to get the implementation of the e-voucher right.

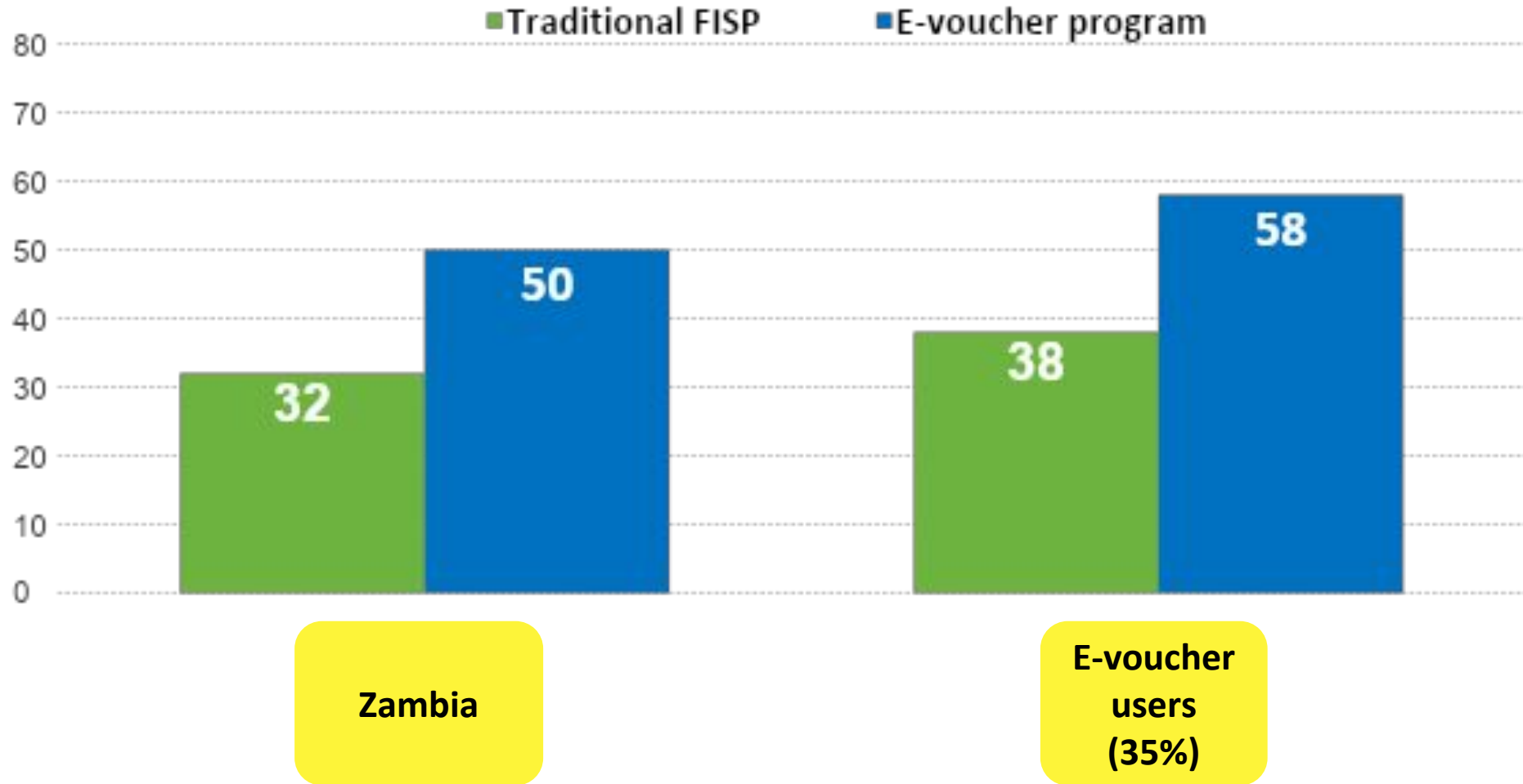
# On the ground, farmers support the e-voucher

Based on what you know, would you say you are satisfied or dissatisfied with the e-voucher programme?



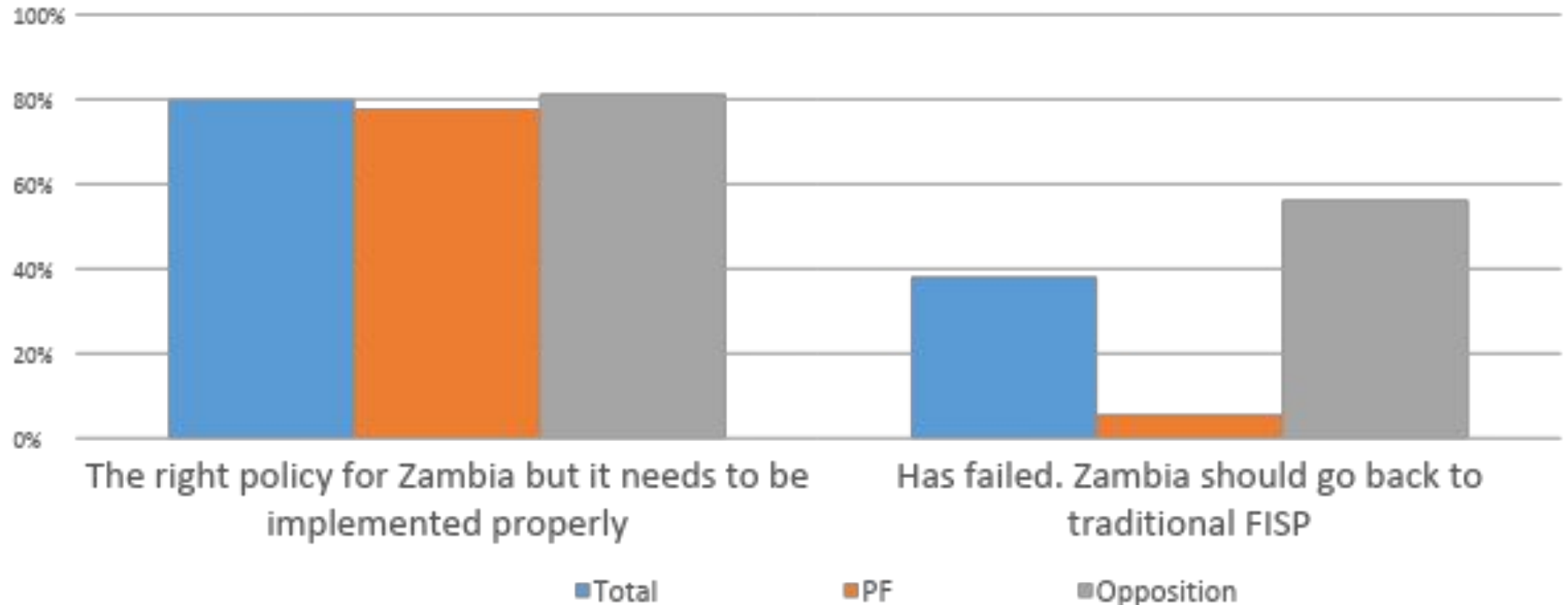
# Zambia prefers the e-voucher
